





Professor Seong-Beom Koh is a distinguished neurologist and professor at Korea University College of Medicine, specializing in movement disorders. He earned his MD from Korea University in 1993, followed by a Master's in Neurology in 1996, and a PhD in Neurology in 1998. He completed his residency training in neurology at Korea University Medical Center during the same period.

His international experience includes a research fellowship in PET Neurology at Hammersmith Hospital, Imperial College, London, from 2006 to 2007. He has been an active member of the Korean Movement Disorder Society since 2003, serving as its President from 2022 to 2023. Currently, he is a professor at Korea University College of Medicine, where he continues to contribute to advancements in gait disorder and movement disorder research.
